PANELS and WORKSHOPS

Just like all its predecessors, 24th Akbank Jazz Festival will also be hosting many panels and workshops.

> PANEL: Straying from the Mainstream

Swift changes took place in the social and cultural life in the whole world during 1960s and these changes not only led to radical formations in the Afro-American population of the United States for equality and freedom, but also deeply influenced the jazz music. The angry but also creative musicians of this period maintained that the mainstream jazz bowed to the hegemony of the white Euro-American culture and revolted against the music of the time and the prevailing economic conditions. Moderated by Radio jazz programmer Hakan Rauf Tüfekçi, Sevin Okyay, Tolga Tüzün and Çağatay Yıldız will discuss in detail in this panel the political, artistic and economic dimensions of the story of the straying from the mainstream of these unique artists who offered the first examples of the free jazz by maintaining that the jazz music of the time moved away from the African music and this digression from the roots contradicted with the concepts of equality and freedom.

> PANEL: Writing on Jazz

The saying that "the music is not only music" fits best to the "jazz" music. The joyful and mysterious world of these writers who promote the latest albums, review the concerts and festivals they watch will be revealed in this panel of the modern jazz writers moderated by the Jazz Magazine's Editor Zuhal Focan. > WORKSHOP: Jazz with Children

At this workshop named "Jazz with the Children" based on the Orff Approach, the swing which is the most basic jazz rhythm will be presented to the children with the company of the body percussion, rhymes and games. Melodic improvisation with the children will be accompanied with Orff Instruments (xylophone, metallophone, percussion instruments) on top of this rhythm, and the resulting songs will be arranged to create a colorful jazz orchestra with the children. **25 October 2014 Saturday, at 14.00, Venue: Akbank Sanat**

> WORKSHOP: Body Music Workshop with Children

One of the festival's events for children is the "Body Music Workshop with Children". The psychologist, pedagogue, writer and player Burcu Tekin will guide us in this children's journey to the magical world of the music with the help of the imagination and creativity of the children in which the sound, silence, hand, fingers, shoe, wind, looks, in short everything is transformed into music and rhythm. A small show will be staged impromptu by the children at the end of the workshop which will open new frontiers in the perception of both the children and the parents.

• JAZZ IN THE CAMPUS

"*Jazz in the Campus*" which has already become a classic of the festival by stirring an air of a festival within the festival continues its way this year too. As one of the most important events of the festival, *Jazz in the Campus* will bring together the joy and enthusiasm of the jazz music with the university students in Gaziantep, Adana, Kayseri, Ankara, Eskişehir, Edirne, Çanakkale and Izmir between 3 and 14 November.

As one of the most unique bands of a jazz genre named "klez jazz" which was created by the musicians mingling the folkloric melodies of the Central and Eastern European peoples with their own local musical traditions and then adorning this music with the elements of jazz in the United States, **Cukunft** will traverse Anatolia under the **Jazz in the Campus**.
